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## Hope and Opportunity in Mozambique



**Temporary Classroom**

The city of Quelimane is struggling under the pressures of poverty, alcohol abuse, and HIV/AIDS. One specific area where we are working is considered a high incident area in regard to HIV/AIDS, theft, and alcohol. The overwhelming majority of the children do not have proper care, or education. In reality, no hope. The average life span in Mozambique is 37 years. The figures posted by the health clinics that are testing for HIV/AIDS state that out of those who are tested, 1 out of 3 test positive (33%). However, even in such circumstances, hope provides the strength to face the challenges knowing

there is the possibility of a better future. Your investment will help transform the lives of children in Quelimane bringing hope and opportunity to vulnerable children in a desperately needy area of the world.

### Projects :

- ◆ Transition home for street boys (to help them break their addiction to sniffing glue ) to prepare them for group home life. Cost: \$30,000.
- ◆ Four complete classrooms for "Peace School" for vulnerable children . Cost 20,000 (\$5,000 per classroom)
